The Kindergarten program and Preschool work together to provide a solid beginning for families who intend to home school in the future. Children develop the skills necessary for a successful elementary journey whether or not parents choose to homeschool in the future. The teacher also acts as a role model demonstrating how to research topics, design lessons, and then how to implement and evaluate a home school program.

Monday & Wednesday

Kinder classes starts at 9:00 AM and runs until 3:05 PM with half an hour for lunch. It makes for a fun, full day! It also means that families who live outside Calgary only have to come to town two days a week.

STEAM activities

STEAM stands for science, technology, engineering, art and math. The kinder kids do a lot of these kinds of activities! Plus they have gym time, sign language instruction and music!

Field trips

The kinder kids explore a variety of places each year - some are like the Calgary Zoo and some are closer to the school like the big open field next door. They also learn about our bee hives and community

Transportation Grant

Parents are responsible for transporting their children to and from the program and on field trips. The transportation grant from Alberta Education is provided to parents to help cover this expense.

Preschool

Each preschool class is set up with care to provide age appropriate toys, learning aids and outdoor time keep children stimulated while they socialize and learn - Tuesdays &/or Thursdays

Class size: Phoenix class sizes are much smaller to ensure each child gets personal attention.

Class length: Not too long . . . little ones need some structure and some play time. Two hours is just enough time for children ages 3-4 years.
