THEME 1: DINOSAURS Sept 13 - Oct 18, 2022 (6 weeks)

Grade 1 - 2	Grade 3 - 4	Grade 5 - 6
<p>The World of Dinosaurs</p> <p>Come explore the world of dinosaurs, especially the small crawling and flying creatures. Discover how we use our senses today to learn about our environment and how they might have used their senses to explore the world at that time. Understand how life (even ancient life) is interconnected.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology units on SMALL CRAWLING & FLYING CREATURES, FOOD CHAINS, the 5 SENSES and ANIMAL SENSES</p>	<p>Dinosaur Art and Games</p> <p>This class will include a variety of fine art projects that explore line, shape and color. They will have ½ hours of dino music and cover various wellness objectives. Kids will have time in the gym or outside if weather permits.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology from FINE ART, MUSIC AND WELLNESS assignments for this time period.</p>	<p>Teleport to the Past</p> <p>Let's teleport back into the past to explore the ancient world of prehistoric plants and trees. We walk through the mud with the dinosaurs and explore prehistoric wetlands and swamps.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology units on WETLANDS and the TREES & FORESTS UNIT.</p>
<p>Dinosaur Art and Games</p> <p>This class will include a variety of fine art projects that explore line, shape and color. They will have ½ hours of dino music and cover various wellness objectives. Kids will have time in the gym or outside if weather permits.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology from FINE ART, MUSIC AND WELLNESS assignments for this time period.</p>	<p>In the Shadow of Dinos</p> <p>We know about dinos from the shadows they leave behind in the fossil record. We will explore the science of paleontology, what rocks and minerals are, the geological record, soil layers and more. We will also fool around with actual shadows and understand how light works and how shadows are made.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology units on ROCKS & MINERALS, LIGHT & SHADOWS</p>	<p>Dinosaur Art and Games</p> <p>This class will include a variety of fine art projects that explore line, shape and color. They will have ½ hours of dino music and cover various wellness objectives. Kids will have time in the gym or outside if weather permits.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology from FINE ART, MUSIC AND WELLNESS assignments for this time period.</p>

In doing so, we will also explore the colors of the desert, hot and cold.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology units on Living Things (Animals), Creating Color and Hot and Cold Temperatures</p>	<p>Mummy Arts, Crafts and Games</p> <p>Explore some Egyptian art projects involving shape, color and texture. Walk like an Egyptian, play some games from the ancient world, and learn more about ancient musical instruments.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology from FINE ART, MUSIC AND WELLNESS assignments for this time period</p>	<p>Ancient Skies</p> <p>Let's explore the ancient cosmos! What did they know of how our solar system works? See how the weather and the cycles of the moon influenced agricultural practices, religious ceremonies, and more. Then we will look to the future to see how these two influence modern day practices.</p> <p>BLENDED students who attend this class are exempt from the Schoology units on Sky science and Weather Watch.</p>	
<p>Mummy Arts, Crafts and Games</p> <p>Explore some Egyptian art projects involving shape, color and texture. Why did they work in stone? How did they move all those really big blocks? Let's find out!
